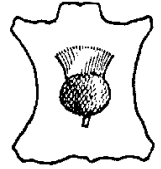

### THE "LAURENSEN-STUART" BOOKBINDER'S SEWING FRAME \*\*

The "Laurenson-Stuart" is an improvement on earlier models, and has particular advantages over traditional sewing frames.

The advantages of the new frame include:

1. No need for keys.
2. The tension on each cord or tape can be adjusted individually.
3. Sections are more conveniently presented for sewing, i.e. flush to the front edge of the sewing frame base.
4. There are no uprights to restrict movement of the sewer's hands or arms.
5. The full width of the base (60cm) is available to accommodate tall volumes
6. The base is extra deep to provide fore-edge support for wide volumes.
7. The frame is supplied 'flat pack' and is simply erected.
8. Non slip rubber feet are fitted as standard.

#### **Note:**

Larger sizes of the "Laurenson-Stuart" Sewing Frame, to accommodate a book up to, for example 1 metre tall, can be made to order to a customer's specification, at nominal extra cost.
