SB50 – FINISHING TOOL CLEANER

SB50 will clean brass, copper and many other materials. Its deep cleansing capabilities will dissolve dirt, grime and grease and leave brass and copper bright and clean.

SB50 is a safe, water soluble, biodegradable solution that contains no hazardous solvents

For best results, dilute SB50 with hot water. A 50/50 dilution would be advisable for very dirty items. For general cleaning and prevention of dirt build-up, a much weaker solution can be used.

Pour the required amount of solution into a suitable container (glass or plastic can be used) and dilute with hot water.

Place the items to be cleaned in the solution, if cleaning tools on wooden handles, stand the tools upright in the container - try not to allow the handle to become wet. You may prefer to just submerge the head of the tool and not the shank although this will leave a 'tide mark' on areas not soaked in the solution.

For cleaning hand centre tools it's a good idea to cut a piece of thin card slightly larger than the container and pierce holes into the card which will allow the wooden handle of the tool to be pushed through it - keep the holes tight so that you can adjust the depth of the tool into the solution - then just lay the card on top of the filled container (adjusting the amount of tool being submersed as necessary)

Leave the items to soak in the solution (soaking time will vary but leaving overnight will give the best results for very old and dirty items) a few hours only may be necessary for light cleaning and tarnish removal. SB50 can be re-used until the blue solution becomes dull and dirty.

Store used solution in a separate container; do not contaminate fresh solution by pouring back into the original bottle.

After the items have been left to soak for the required amount of time, rinse well with water and lightly brush with a small 'nail brush' and see the dirt and grime disappear. Dry the items thoroughly with a soft cloth or paper towel (it's a good idea to disburse any remaining water with a 'hair dryer') when dry you can rub over the tool with a piece of soft leather to obtain a nice smooth finish.
